"Of course I did!" replied the brother-in-law. "I have perfect eyesight".

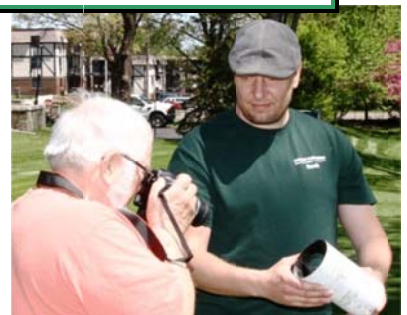
"Where did it go?" says Arthur.
