Greetings!

I want to thank everyone for your cooperation during the garage cleaning. I know it is a huge inconvenience and very difficult for many of you so I want you to know I really appreciate your willingness to help. I hope you are all enjoying the convenience of the new automatic door openers in the garage. I know I have used it several times when my hands were full of groceries!

I have several updates and suggestions for June:

1. The new carpet that was scheduled for June 3 had to be postponed until Monday June 8th. If you need to get out between the hours of 9:30 -4 or 5, you will not be able to use the elevators or the garage entry during these hours. I apologize for the inconvenience but we will try to complete the job as quickly as possible.

2. The blood pressure clinic will be held in the Clubroom on June 4 at 1pm.
3. There will be no water yoga/aerobics on June 6 or 22.
4. There will be no parking in the East lot June 4-6 due to the garage sale. If you park outside, please park anywhere *west* of the 45 entry so we have parking for the garage sale. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
5. Please be sure to lock the park gate with your pool key after you enter or exit.
6. I need to clarify to those who use the front entry for smoking; you must be 15' from the bottom of the stairs.
7. Please do not let strangers in the front doors. Family members must be buzzed in and should not have your code unless it has been approved by the office. These rules are important for the security of our Residents. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
8. Soliciting is not allowed in the building, even for Residents. Flyers, etc. cannot be distributed in the buildings without prior approval from the office.
9. I have received complaints about noise due to loud volumes on TV sets, banging cupboards and doors and showers at 12-4 in the morning. Please keep in mind that quiet hours are between 10 pm and 8 am so as not to disturb your neighbors.
10. Please be sure to supervise any children that may be visiting you when you are in the pool area or Club Room. Toys should be put away and food should be eaten on the patio area outside or in the Clubroom. Children should not be allowed to play on exercise equipment or on the computers without adult supervision. This is not so bad as they will probably be able to teach us all something new!
11. Last month we had a demonstration from the Fire Department at our monthly apartment meeting (ROMA). They introduced a new product called Fire Stop that they recommend tenants have in their kitchen. It is a fire extinguisher that attaches to the stove vent with a magnet. If you have a fire on top of your stove it will automatically extinguish it. They also suggested that anyone who is frying or cooking with grease should have a cookie sheet beside the stove to set on top of the pan if a fire breaks out. Please stop by the office if you would like more information.
12. Please don't forget all of our weekly activities that are posted on the bulletin boards and in the elevator. We love to have new people!
