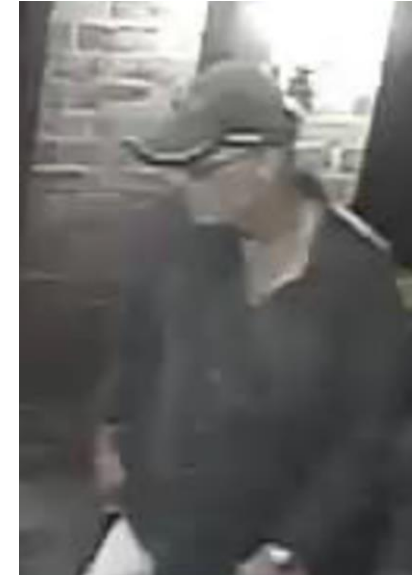
I have the garage cleaning scheduled for August 17-18. All cars will need to be parked outside so we can
